Vision - Mission - Values:

Definition:

Vision is the direction we are going.

Mission is the steps we are taking to accomplish the vision.

Core Values are how we treat each other / work together along the way.

Three tips:

1 - Your vision statement needs to be:

Short

Memorable

Inspiring

A direction but not a destination

2 - Your mission statement needs to:

Have clear steps to accomplish the vision.

Be simple enough that everyone remembers it.

Have job descriptions, roles and expectations clearly spelled out around it.

3 - Core values should be:

Something you currently do as well as things you are aspiring to be.
